

DAY 2: RENEWAL

READ:

PSALM 51:10 (ESV)

CREATE IN ME A CLEAN HEART, O GOD,
AND RENEW A RIGHT SPIRIT WITHIN ME.

REFLECT:

WHEN WAS THE LAST TIME YOU ATE WITH A DIRTY UTENSIL? I'M TALKING ABOUT A VISIBLY DIRTY ONE. YOU SAT DOWN AT THE TABLE TO EAT AND THE ONLY OPTION AVAILABLE WAS EATING WITH SOMETHING DIRTY?

IF WE WOULDN'T EAT WITH SOMETHING VISIBLY DIRTY, THEN WHY WOULD WE WANT GOD TO SETTLE FOR A LIFE WE'RE NOT WILLING TO ALLOW HIM TO CLEAN. DAVID WRITES THIS PSALM AFTER HE HAD COMMITTED AN ACT THAT WE WOULD HAVE DISQUALIFIED HIM FOR. HIS PRAYER TO GOD WAS, "CREATE IN ME WHAT'S RIGHT, LORD." TODAY TAKE A MOMENT AND SEARCH WITHIN FOR THINGS THAT GOD MAY WANT TO CLEAN.

PRAY:

DEAR LORD, I ADMIT THAT I'VE NOT GIVEN YOU EVERYTHING THAT I SHOULD. TODAY I'M ASKING YOU TO CLEAN THOSE AREAS OF MY HEART THAT NO ONE SEES. THANK YOU FOR YOUR PATIENCE. IN JESUS NAME, AMEN.
