READ:

JOHN 17:21 (ESV)

21 THAT THEY MAY ALL BE ONE, JUST AS YOU, FATHER, ARE IN ME, AND I IN YOU, THAT THEY ALSO MAY BE IN US, SO THAT THE WORLD MAY BELIEVE THAT YOU HAVE SENT ME.

REFLECT:

IF THERE IS ONE THING THE ENEMY LOVES; IT'S
DISUNITY. AFRICAN HUNTERS ARE KNOWN TO TRAVEL
IN PACKS WHEN DEALING WITH WILDLIFE. IN THE
EVENT THAT ONE IS ATTACKED BY A SAVAGE BEAST,
THEY HAVE A STRATEGY.

WHILE THE ANIMAL IS FOCUSED ON THE ONE, THE REMAINING HUNTERS UNITE TO ATTACK THE PREDATOR WHICHS RESULTS IN MINIMAL DAMAGE FOR THEIR FRIEND. THE ENEMY IS OUT TO ATTACK AND WANTS NOTHING BETTER THAN TO KEEP YOU ISOLATED. THE STRENGTH OF YOUR FIGHT REMAINS IN THE STRENGTH OF COMMUNITY.
